We just completed the "Jefferson Era" in history class. Here are some things that they learned:

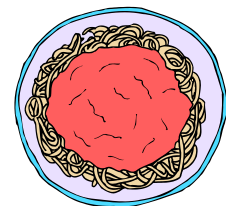
- Thomas Jefferson's influence on Government

Mark 10:45

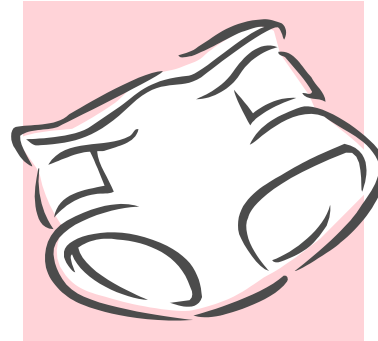
We leave for our trip to Chicago bright and early Monday morning. Please make sure your child is at school by 7:30am!

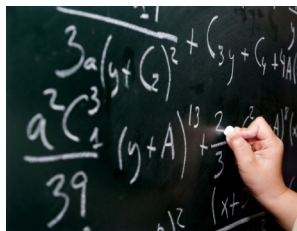
