Here's what we have been doing this week!

Language Arts

We are in Unit 5 of our Language Arts units! Last week we read a story called Firefighters. We talked about how each firefighter has a job to do and he or she is responsible for completing that job. We starting talking about pronouns, too. This week we read a story called Carl the Complainer. This was a cute story about how to be responsible community members. We are working on writing a persuasive letter. We also started writing in cursive! The kids are excited to learn this new way of writing!

Science
