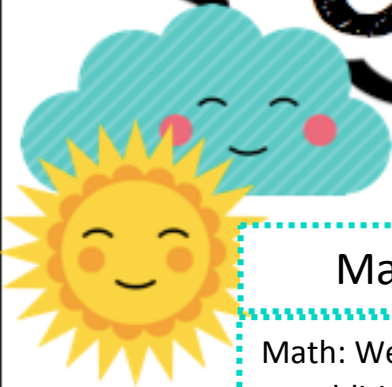


News from the Classroom

Week 34

Math + Science

Math: We will continue to work on addition fact strategies. We will also be working with unit containers for measuring liquid capacity, identifying geometric solids, and using dollar bills to pay for items. Another busy week in math!

Science: We will begin our new unit on SPACE this week! A fun, hands on demonstration will help us learn about the earth's cycle, explaining night and day. We will also learn about how the atmosphere surrounds and protects the earth and that space is beyond that. (Our reading unit has given us lots of background knowledge for this Science Unit. ☺)

Language Focus

In reading, we are continuing to read informational texts about space, as well as the planets and sun. We will be learning about text features and using them to locate information in our texts. We will also be working on using illustrations and details in the text to describe its key ideas. In writing we are beginning to learn about writing informational text. The students will be going through the whole writing process again to write and publish their own "All About Book" on an animal. More details will be coming as we work on this project over the next several weeks.
