2018-19 Registration

Registration is now open! There were no increases in tuition for childcare and preschool. Kindergarten increased by 1% and first - eighth grade increased by 2%. These rate increases are less than the cost of living index. Please submit the registration form, registration fee, PTL enhancement fee (all fees must be paid at time of registration), electronic fund transfer form, new child information card, copy of birth certificate (K-8), health appraisal (TK and kindergartners need section II completed, vision and hearing, by a physician), updated immunizations and childcare needs. The registration fee is \$150 per child or \$275 for families with two or more children. Please contact the school with any questions.

Tuition Assistance Applications

St. Michael Lutheran School is able to offer tuition assistance to qualifying families. The amount of tuition assistance available varies from year to year because all tuition assistance money is generated annually from many special events as well as generous donations of individuals. We use the services of TADS, a national company which specializes in analyzing financial need. Applications for the 2018-19 school year are now available online at stmikeschool.org.
