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Second Grade Program

The theme for second grade is "Around the World in 180 Days". Generally, this is centered around our history curriculum and is extended through projects, field trips, and guest speakers. The students create a passport and record some facts they learn in each place we visit.

The following information is an overview of topics and units we study in the various subject areas.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Phonics and Reading

In second grade we use Scott Foresman Reading Street. This program is a good blend of phonics, reading, spelling, writing, listening and speaking. The skills are connected to stories from many different genres. The stories also connect to science and social studies topics. We use a mixture of whole group and small group reading instruction.

Writing

Our writing program is a combination of writing using the 6+1 Traits of writing as well as the Collins Writing Program. The 6+1 traits of writing include: Conventions, Word Choice, Voice, Sentence Fluency, and

Organization. We do several "Types" of writing each with different sets of requirements. In longer writing assignments, students focus on perfecting 3 Focus Correction Areas which are created from the traits.



MATHEMATICS

Students will learn to:

- Add and Subtract math facts to 18
- Add and subtract any 3 digit number (with carrying and regrouping)
- Round numbers to the nearest 10



- Add and Subtract dollars and cents
- Find perimeter
- Tell time to the minute
- Measure to the nearest inch, half inch, quarter inch, and centimeter
- Read graphs
- Find one-half, one-third, and one-quarter of numbers and groups of objects
- Understanding multiplication and division
- Estimate sums
