Here's what we have been doing in class!

Language Arts

We just finished reading a book called The Earth Dragon Awakes. This is a historical fiction book about the massive earthquake that happened in 1904 in San Francisco. We learn about two families and how they responded to the devastation in their city. We are also reading a short story called Seek the Sun. In this story we will learn about what a community did when tall building was built in their town. This story is based on a court case in Japan that resulted in a law that limited the amount of shadow that can fall on building nearby.

Science

We finished up our unit on Heat energy and we are now learning about light energy. We will learn the science words: transparent, translucent, and opaque. We will also learn a bit about how light refracts or bends. We will talk about the visible spectrum and the colors found in the spectrum.

Math

We are also beginning to learn about multiplication and rounding numbers to the nearest 10.


History
