## 2017-18 Registration

Registration is now open! Please submit the registration form, registration fee, PTL enhancement fee, excel in giving form, child information card, copy of birth certificate (K-8), health appraisal (*TK and kindergartners need section II completed, vision and hearing, by a physician*), updated immunizations and childcare needs. The registration fee is \$150 per child or \$275 for families with 2 or more children. Please contact the school with any questions.

## Tuition Assistance Applications

St. Michael Lutheran School is able to offer tuition assistance to qualifying families. The amount of tuition assistance available varies from year to year because all tuition assistance money is generated annually from many special events as well as generous donations of individuals.
