Week 27

Math + Science

Math: We will start out this week with a test! Then we start really getting into subtraction. We will identify dozen and half dozen, estimate and measure using feet, and create our own measuring device! Keep practicing counting coins with your child. These are skills that your child needs tremendously.

Science: We learned that making sap turn into syrup requires you to boil it! The water from the sap evaporates and the sugar is what's left. We ended up with 1.5 gallons of sap, so how much syrup do you think we'll end up with? We will taste our syrup right away on Monday ☺

Language Focus

We've been writing a book! It is all about our Maple Syrup process. I hope to have it finished to be brought home by the end of the week ☺

Our reading and language unit is still focusing on plants and life cycles. We've been able to translate what we're learning about plants over to previous learning of animal life cycles in Science. That's awesome!

Specifically in reading analysis, we are categorizing vocab, learning sequence of events, cause and effect, and the use of visual supports.

In phonics, we are learning about contractions: I've=I+have.

Leveled readers are sent home every Monday. Do you read these with your child?
